



Getting Started with GnuCash



Video 1: Installing GnuCash

GnuCash can be installed on various types of operating systems including windows, Mac and Linux . It is also available for earlier operating systems as well as the most recent operating systems . GnuCash is a free open source accounting software which can be freely downloaded at the GnuCash.org. In this tutorial I will walk you through the steps of installing GnuCash on a Windows desktop computer.

Instructions:

Windows Installation:

Download the installer: Go to the official GnuCash website and download the latest stable release for Windows.

- 1. Run the installer:** Locate the downloaded .exe file and double-click it to start the installation process.
- 2. Follow the prompts:** Follow the instructions in the installation wizard to complete the installation.

Mac Installation

- 1. Download the installer:** Go to the GnuCash website or the Sourceforge/Github projects and download the correct disk image for your Mac's processor (Intel or Apple Silicon).
- 2. Open the disk image:** Double-click the downloaded .dmg file to open it.
- 3. Copy to Applications:** Drag the GnuCash app icon from the disk image into your Applications folder. If you need online quotes, also drag the "Install Online Quotes" icon into your Applications folder.
- 4. Close the disk image:** You can now eject and close the disk image.
- 5. Launch GnuCash:** Open the application from your Applications folder or by clicking its icon on your system.
